

LWCF Overview



- A Federal, State and Local Partnership since 1965 = State Assistance Program
- Purpose: to provide matching grants to States and local governments for the acquisition and development of public outdoor recreation areas and facilities.
- Funding: U.S. Department of Interior –
 National Park Service LWCF Act



LWCF Overview


- Grants provided to the States, and through the States to Subrecipients
- Matching Reimbursement up to 50%
- Property must be protected *in perpetuity* for the purpose of *outdoor recreation*.
- 388 sites in VA
- VOP (SCORP)





2022 LWCF Grant Round

- \$11.64 million LWCF Funding Available
- Acquisition & Development
- \$250,000 minimum request (\$500K minimum total project cost)
- \$2 million max request*
- Must be able to have public outdoor recreation opportunities available/completed within 3 years.





2022 LWCF Schedule

- Feb 1 announced
- Mar 15 Applications due*
 - Email submission by 4 pm
- April Grant Committee Meeting
- Recommendations for funding contact applicants - site visits
- Complete additional documentation (NEPA, etc)
- Submit to NPS for initial review
- July Grants.gov submission





Applicant Eligibility

- Local Governments
- State Agencies
- Tribal Governments



Final landowner must be able to keep land protected and managed in perpetuity.

- All scored together equally.
- On application, please provide contact of specific entity lead (not contractor)

Eligible Projects - Development

- Sports & Playfields
- Picnic facilities
- Trails
- Swimming facilities
- Boating facilities
- Fishing/hunting
- Renovation[^]
- Beautification

- Accessible Facilities
- Beautification
- Camping
- Interpretive/exhibit facilities
- Spectator facilities
- Community gardens
- Target range



Eligible – Support Facilities

- Needed by the public for outdoor recreation use of an area: roads, parking, utilities, restrooms, kiosks, simple trail shelters, walkways, pavilions, equip rental space = simple roof or cover
- Operation & Maintenance storage, admin offices = in scope and boundary
- MUST directly serve the outdoor recreation



Ineligible Projects

- Not eligible acquisitions:
 - Historic Sites/Structures (unless secondary)
 - Semi-Professional/Pro Sports
 - Non-public game refuges
 - Mainly for indoor facilities
 - Lodges, hotels, motels, restaurants (indoor, forprofit establishments)
 - Agricultural purposes/preservation



Ineligible Projects

- Not eligible Development:
 - INDOOR FACILITIES = meeting rooms, restaurants, lodges, kitchens, equipment sales, etc.
 - Professional facilities
 - Exclusive uses
 - Mobile recreation units
 - Indoor displays
 - Employee housing



Funding Basics

- Payments made on reimbursement basis
 - Must be able to fund project fully up front and provide proof of payment of agreed amount

- Match requirement is 50% of project cost
 - Federal Funds cannot be used as match including Recovery funds*
 - Can include certain donation values



Funding - Acquisitions

- NO PURCHASES can be made prior to grant agreement release*
- Only cost of acquisition purchase eligible (surveys and appraisals not reimbursable)
- Based on appraised and reviewed value
- Appraisals
 - UASFLA (Yellow Book) level and Reviewed
 - Within one year of when NPS will receive it



Funding - Development

- Accessibility & protection of resources
- Must be designed in conformance with ABA and ADA
- Construction & Renovation
- Site Planning
- Engineering & Architectural Services
- Contractor = Materials/Labor



Items of Note:

- ENTIRE park (including existing property) must be 6(f) protected upon funding.
- Public Recreation will be available w/in 3 years of acquisition or at completion of construction
- Be clear about park boundary, acreage, and all existing conditions.





Is your project ready?

- Beyond conceptual
- Public support
- Clear scope of work
- Financial capability



 NEPA and NHPA documentation required prior to NPS authorization

Projects that are not shovel ready may be recommended for next Grants.gov opportunity.*





Application Items

- The application helps:
 - The Scoring Committee
 - Determine Project Readiness
 - Present the project to the NPS
 - Evaluate funding request
 - Let's take a look!

Documents Walkthrough

- Checklist do you have the needed info?
- DCR Application eligibility & scoring
- A&R Form NPS required
- Budget detailed and comprehensive, match info, dedicated funding source
- Timeline considers all factors
- Maps (3) boundary, site plan, location

- Deadline is 4:00PM on Tuesday, March 15, 2022.
- All applications must be submitted electronically by this deadline. RecreationGrants@dcr.Virginia.gov
- Late submissions will not be accepted.



Grant Terms

- Three Year Project Period
- NPS will likely not allow drawdown of funding or ground disturbance until the NEPA/NHPA is approved.
 - Tribal Consult (NPS)
 - Further clarification
- Subgrant:
 NPS → DCR → Sponsor





Project Closeout

- Site Inspection
- Acknowledgement Sign
- Final Deed with 6f
- Final Map
- Proof of Payment
- NPS closeout
- Transfer of Funds







In General: LWCF Applications


- All eligible projects will be considered present what you have.
- NPS has final authority; DCR is your advocate.
- Be patient advise partners it can take time to get authorized.
- Effective way to protect parkland; develop access for all; invest in local public resources
