Wear clothes, shoes/boots/waders and gloves to get muddy in. Also layers appropriate for the weather. (We recommend bringing extra clothing and shoes to change into afterward.)

Teams will travel by boat, foot or car to selected salvage locations. Children are welcome if accompanied by an adult. Bring lifejackets for children; adults are encouraged to bring lifejackets if they have them.

Drinks and snacks will be provided. Lunch will be available at the Claytor Lake State Park meeting facility. Event end times will vary by team but approximately noon to 1:00.
